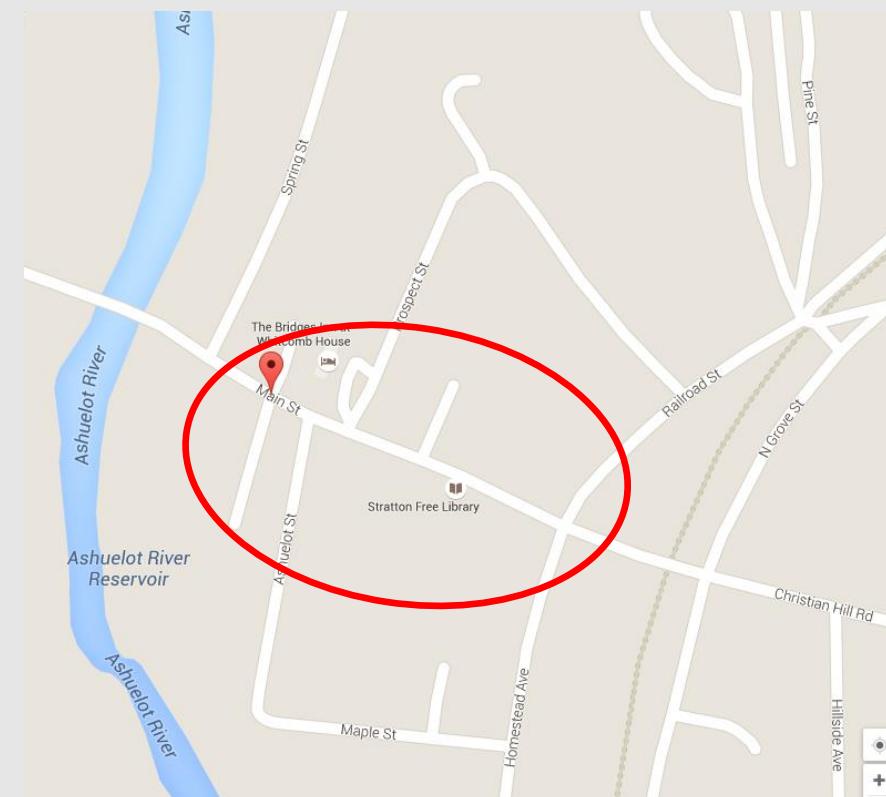


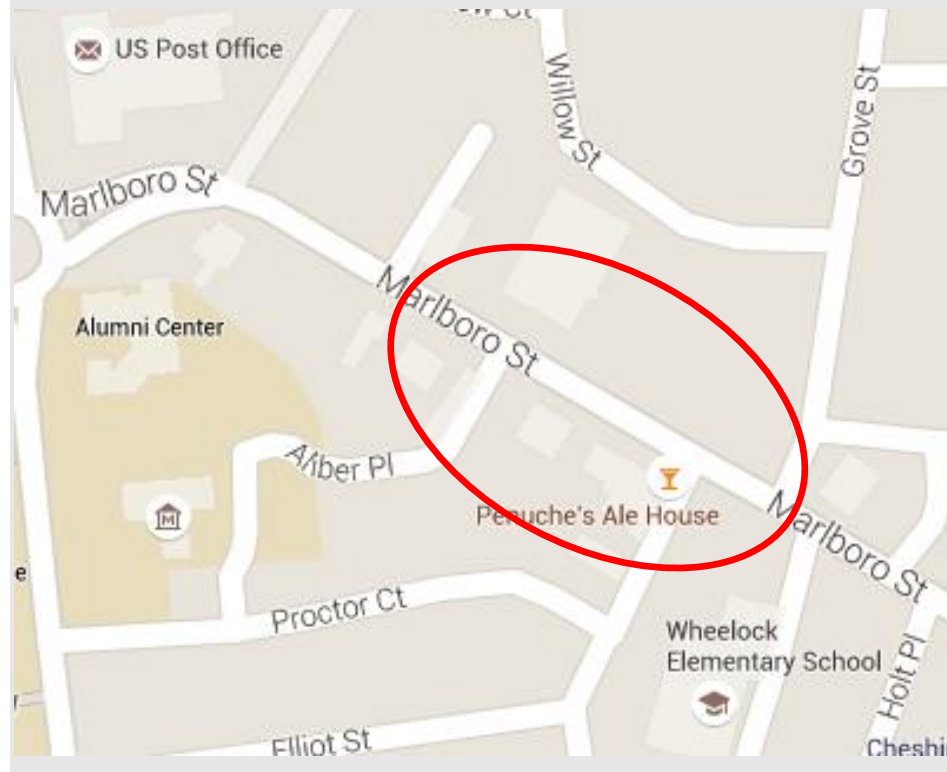
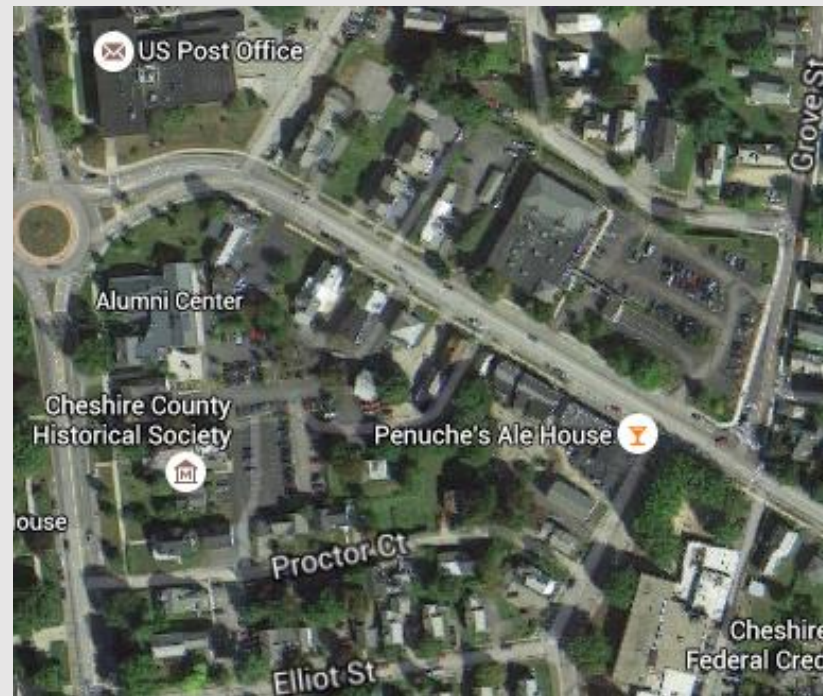
COMPLETE STREETS DEMONSTRATIONS 2015

Southwest Region Planning Commission has partnered with Healthy Monadnock 2020 and the Monadnock Region Transportation Management Association to host two "Complete Streets" demonstration events in late summer/early fall. These events will be an opportunity to temporarily transform a segment of a roadway for a day to interactively show how the safety of all users can be taken into consideration in roadway design and how the streetscape is a vital component of a place's identity and quality of life. COMPLETE STREETS DEMONSTRATION – ELEMENTS

5' Bike Lane, protected from on-street parking by a 2.5' buffer of planters / vegetation or other physical barrier:



Temporary crosswalks and landscaped bumpouts; Food trucks and vendors; Parks in Parking Spaces



Extended sidewalk and seating space; Creative street furniture; Creative use of public space (e.g. putting green)
